This letter is being written on behalf of the family of Police Officer William C. Phillips #738, who served protecting the University of Illinois at Chicago community. P.O. Phillips served with honor and dignity during his time as a Police Officer at the UICPD. Prior to joining UIC, P.O. Phillips worked at the South Holland Police Department in 2005 and the Cook County Sheriff Corrections Maximum Security Division #10 from 2005 to 2008. Officer Phillips also held a degree in Journalism from the Southern Illinois University of Carbondale.

On February 23, 2010 Officer Phillips succumbed to his battle with Lymphoma. Officer Phillips was 36 years old.

We are all shocked and saddened by the tragic loss of Officer Phillips. He was a Son, Brother, Husband, Father, and Friend. He is survived by his wife Martina Phillips (CPD 004th district) and two children. We will be holding a Benefit for the family of Officer Phillips on October 22nd, 2010 at the FOP Lodge 1412 West Washington, Chicago IL. We will be conducting a silent auction and raffle with all proceeds going directly to the P.O. William Phillips Family Fund.
